CAMP REGISTRATION

Register early to avoid disappointment. Registrations will be processed in the order received. No spaces will be held without full payment. Once registration and fees are received, participants will receive an e-mail confirmation with a link to a camper packet. It is the responsibility of the participant to appear in camp on the correct day and hour without additional notice.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

Oglebay Institute is committed to offering a wide variety of camps. As a result, camps sometimes have to be cancelled due to insufficient enrollment. In such cases, you will be notified no later than 72 hours before the camp start date and the full fee will be refunded. Oglebay Institute reserves the right to substitute instructors.

In order for participants to cancel and receive a full refund, they must notify the facility and cancel on or before April 1. After April 1, you must notify the facility and cancel at least 2 WEEKS before the camp start date. No refunds will be granted less than two weeks from the camp start date, and there is no proration of camp fees once the camp has started. In addition, a cancellation fee of \$20 is in effect for cancellations made after April 1, even those made within a two-week period.

Through specific repeatable techniques, both physical and mental, performers of all disciplines discover the core of a song by creating specificity and truth that keep the singer in the moment.
